

2026 Charter and Bylaws – What Members Need to Know

Why update?

The current historical documents combine governance and operating rules. The proposed structure separates them.

What is the Charter?

The foundational document describing the Club's identity, purpose, mission, nonprofit character, and document hierarchy.

What are the Bylaws?

The governance document covering membership, Board responsibilities, officers, meetings, voting, finances, conflicts, records, and amendments.

What are Operating Rules?

Board-approved day-to-day rules for aircraft use, scheduling, training, safety, maintenance, facilities, and operating procedures.

What changes for members?

Clarify voting rights, Board/member authority, conflicts of interest, financial oversight, member petitions, and recordkeeping.

What does not change immediately?

Day-to-day flying rules remain handled through Operating Rules and Board action.

How do I comment?

Use the feedback form by August 28, 2026.

When is the vote?

September 1, 2026, subject to final Board confirmation.
